REENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1344

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact three new sections to chapter 15-40.1 of the North
2 Dakota Century Code or in the alternative to create and enact three new sections to
3 chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the reimbursement of school
4 districts for increases in teacher compensation; and to amend and reenact subdivision a of
5 subsection 2 of section 15-40.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code or in the alternative to
6 amend and reenact section 15.1-27-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to per
7 student payments.

8 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

9 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective,
10 subdivision a of subsection 2 of section 15-40.1-06 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
11 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

12 2. a. The educational support per student ~~during for~~ for the first year of the ~~1999-2001~~
13 ~~2001-03~~ biennium ~~must be~~ is two thousand ~~one~~ two hundred ~~forty-five~~
14 ~~fifty-five~~ dollars ~~and~~. The educational support per student for the second year
15 of the ~~1999-2001~~ 2001-03 biennium ~~the educational support per student must~~
16 ~~be~~ is two thousand two hundred ~~thirty~~ seventy-eight dollars ~~and~~. The
17 educational support per student is the basis for calculating grants-in-aid on a
18 per student basis as provided in sections 15-40.1-07 and 15-40.1-08.

19 **SECTION 2.** If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, a new section to
20 chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

21 **Definitions.** For purposes of this Act:

22 1. "Compensation" includes all salaries, benefits, commissions, memberships, the
23 provision of housing, the provision of vehicles, and any other payments, in lieu of

1 payments, or services, reportable as gross income under the Internal Revenue
2 Code.

3 2. "Teacher" means any individual who is licensed to teach by the education
4 standards and practices board or approved to teach by the education standards
5 and practices board. The term does not include administrators, assistant or
6 associate administrators, principals, assistant or associate principals, special
7 education directors, vocational education directors, directors of multidistrict special
8 education units, directors of area vocational and technology centers, athletic or
9 activity directors, and substitute teachers.

10 **SECTION 3.** If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, a new section to
11 chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

12 **Compensation of teachers - Claim for reimbursement.**

13 1. On or before October first of each year or within thirty days after the conclusion of
14 the negotiation process provided for in chapter 15-38.1, the board of a school
15 district may file a claim with the superintendent of public instruction for the
16 reimbursement of moneys to be expended by the district during the school year to
17 increase the compensation of teachers employed by the district.

18 2. The claim must include:

19 a. The number of full-time equivalent teachers employed by the district as of
20 September fifteenth;

21 b. The number of full-time equivalent teachers who will receive an increase in
22 compensation over the amount paid during the previous school year; and

23 c. The total amount of the increase in compensation.

24 3. For the 2001-02 school year, the reimbursement provided for in this section may
25 not exceed one thousand seven hundred fifty dollars multiplied by the number of
26 full-time equivalent teachers employed by the district as of September 15, 2001.

27 For the 2002-03 school year, the reimbursement provided for in this section may
28 not exceed three thousand five hundred dollars multiplied by the number of
29 full-time equivalent teachers employed by the district as of September 15, 2002.

30 4. For purposes of this section, the claim of a district may include proportionate
31 expenditures made by the district to compensate individuals employed as teachers

1 by the special education unit or the area vocational and technology center to which
2 the district belongs.

3 **SECTION 4.** If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, a new section to
4 chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

5 **Compensation of teachers - Distribution of reimbursement.** The superintendent of
6 public instruction shall distribute approximately one-sixth of the total amount to which each
7 school district is entitled under this Act on or before the first day of each November, December,
8 January, February, March, and May.

9 **SECTION 5. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-27-04 of the North Dakota Century Code as
10 created by House Bill No. 1045, as approved by the fifty-seventh legislative assembly, is
11 amended and reenacted as follows:

12 **15.1-27-04. Per student payment.** The per student payment to which each school
13 district is entitled for the first year of the biennium is two thousand ~~one~~ two hundred ~~forty-five~~
14 fifty-five dollars. The per student payment to which each school district is entitled for the
15 second year of the biennium is two thousand two hundred ~~thirty~~ seventy-eight dollars. The per
16 student amount is the basis for calculating state payments to school districts, as provided in
17 sections 15.1-27-06 and 15.1-27-07.

18 **SECTION 6.** A new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is
19 created and enacted as follows:

20 **Definitions.** For purposes of this Act:

- 21 1. "Compensation" includes all salaries, benefits, commissions, memberships, the
22 provision of housing, the provision of vehicles, and any other payments, in lieu of

11 September fifteenth;
- 12 b. The number of full-time equivalent teachers who will receive an increase in
13 compensation over the amount paid during the previous school year; and
- 14 c. The total amount of the increase in compensation.
- 15 3. For the 2001-02 school year, the reimbursement provided for in this section may
16 not exceed one thousand seven hundred fifty dollars multiplied by the number of
17 full-time equivalent teachers employed by the district as of September 15, 2001.
18 For the 2002-03 school year, the reimbursement provided for in this section may
19 not exceed three thousand five hundred dollars multiplied by the number of
20 full-time equivalent teachers employed by the district as of September 15, 2002.
- 21 4. For purposes of this section, the claim of a district may include proportionate
22 expenditures made by the district to compensate individuals employed as teachers
23 by the special education unit or the area vocational and technology center to which
24 the district belongs.

25 **SECTION 8.** A new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is
26 created and enacted as follows:

27 **Compensation of teachers - Distribution of reimbursements.** The superintendent
28 of public instruction shall distribute approximately one-sixth of the total amount to which each
29 school district is entitled under this Act on or before the first day of each November, December,
30 January, February, March, and May.
