- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-52.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to use of pharmacy benefits managers by the public employees
- 3 retirement board.

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## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-52.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Board to contract with pharmacy benefits manager. To the extent allowed under federal law, subject to the board successfully negotiating this feature with its insurance carrier, and notwithstanding section 54-52.1-04, the board shall contract with one or more domestic or nondomestic pharmacy benefits managers to facilitate the purchase of eligible Canadian prescription drugs by eligible employees and persons receiving retiree health benefits. The program must be voluntary for eligible employees and persons receiving retiree health benefits. The board may forgive all or a part of any prescription copayments as an incentive for eligible employees and persons receiving retiree health benefits to participate in the program. To facilitate participation in the program, eligible employees and persons eligible to receive retiree health benefits may authorize the board to pay the pharmacy benefits manager for prescriptions obtained from eligible Canadian pharmacies. If the board is not able to negotiate the pharmacy benefits manager feature with its carrier, the board may "hold harmless" its carrier to the extent that the carrier utilizes a pharmacy benefits manager to facilitate the purchase of eligible

Canadian prescription drugs as provided in this section.
