- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-44.4 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to an information program regarding the state's purchasing practices;

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-44.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

**Procurement information program.** The office of management and budget shall implement a program to inform potential vendors in the state of the state's commodities and services purchasing system. The information provided through this program must include information regarding approved vendor status, selection criteria, and commodity and service specifications. The office of management and budget may contract with a third party to assist in implementing the program and in distributing the information under the program.

SECTION 2. REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL. During the 2005-06 interim, the director of the office of management and budget shall report to the legislative council on the status of the procurement information program under section 1 of this Act. This report must include information regarding what information the program provides to potential vendors, the manner in which the information is provided to potential vendors, the number of potential vendors reached through the program, whether the program should continue, and whether there are potential changes that could be made to the state's purchasing system in order to assist North Dakota businesses in obtaining a larger share of the state's procurement opportunities.
