- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 23-35-12 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the qualifications of local health officers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 23-35-12 of the North Dakota

 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - A local health officer shall serve a term of five years, subject to removal for cause by the governing body or the district board of health. The health officer must be hold, at a physician licensed to practice medicine in this state and minimum, a bachelor's degree in an allied health profession and have experience and knowledge in public health. The health officer need not be a resident of the public health unit. The appointee shall qualify by filing the constitutional oath of office in the manner provided for the members of the board of health. If the state health officer finds a local health officer is failing to perform the duties of the position, the state health officer may report the case to the governing body of the appropriate city, county, or district board of health. At the next meeting of the city's or county's governing body or district board of health, the governing body or district board of health shall declare the office vacant and may appoint another physician individual to fill the unexpired term, or shall report the matter to the board of health, and the board shall declare the office vacant and promptly shall appoint another physician individual to fill the unexpired term.
