- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 37-18 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to department of veterans' affairs employees; to amend and reenact
- 3 section 37-14-18 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to county veterans' service
- 4 officers; and to provide an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 37-14-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

37-14-18. County veterans' service officer - Appointment - Duties. The board of

9 county commissioners of each county of the state of North Dakota shall appoint, employ, and

pay, on a full-time or part-time basis, an officer to be known as a county veterans' service

11 officer. An individual may serve as a county veterans' service officer in more than one county.

12 The appointment must be made with the prior advice of the commissioner of veterans' affairs,

and in accordance with veterans' preference as provided in section 37-19.1-02. The county

14 veterans' service officer must maintain accreditation by the department of veterans' affairs

15 within two years of appointment. It is the duty of the county veterans' service officer to become

16 acquainted with the laws, both state and federal, enacted for the benefit of returning

servicemen and servicewomen to assist such returning members of the armed forces in the

18 presentation, proof, and establishment of such claims, privileges, and rights as they have. It

19 also is the duty of the county veterans' service officer to actively cooperate with and to

20 coordinate the activities of the state and federal agencies within the county which the officer

21 serves to facilitate their operation and ensure promptness in the solution of the problems

22 concerned with the reestablishment of returning servicemen and servicewomen in civilian

23 pursuits.

1 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 37-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is 2 created and enacted as follows: 3 Department of veterans' affairs employees - Conservatorship activities 4 prohibited. An employee of the department of veterans' affairs may not serve as a 5 conservator for a person receiving benefits or services from the department. 6 SECTION 3. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS - TRAINING POSITIONS. 7 The commissioner of veterans' affairs may use up to two of the department of veterans' affairs' 8 existing full-time equivalent positions as training officers for the biennium beginning July 1, 9 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. 10 **SECTION 4.** APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the 11 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$20,000, or so much 12 of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of 13 arranging for department of veterans' affairs accreditation training for all county veterans' 14 service officers in the state, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
