- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-06-12 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to a requirement for lockdown drills at schools.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-06-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15.1-06-12. Emergency and disaster drills Implementation.
- 1. Each <u>public and nonpublic</u> school <u>district superintendent</u> shall <u>implementconduct</u> fire,
 tornado, and other emergency or disaster drills, <u>including lockdown drills</u>.
 - 2. The lockdown drills required by subsection 1 must:
- 10 <u>a. Be designed by a committee that includes:</u>
- 11 (1) The principal of the public school or, in the case of a nonpublic school, the administrator:
- 13 (2) A representative of the law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction over

 the area in which the school is located;
 - (3) A representative of the fire department that has jurisdiction over the area in which the school is located; and
 - (4) A representative of any other emergency response entity recommended by the listed committee members.
- b. Be designed to include security measures that are appropriate to situations
 involving:
- 21 (1) The release of a hazardous material; and
- 22 (2) The presence of an armed individual on or near the school premises.
- 23 <u>c.</u> Occur at least twice during each regular school calendar.
