- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the extension
- 2 service, northern crops institute, upper great plains transportation institute, main research
- 3 center, branch research centers, and agronomy seed farm; to amend and reenact section
- 4 4-14.2-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the northern crops council; to provide
- 5 for transfers; to provide contingent funding; to provide an exemption; and to declare an
- 6 emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
9	as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
10	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
11	other income, to the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops
12	institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch
13	research centers, and agronomy seed farm for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
14	North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops institute, the upper great
15	plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch research centers, and
16	agronomy seed farm, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as
17	follows:

- 20 the sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium
- 21 beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

22 SECTION 3. CONTINGENT FUNDING - WILLISTON RESEARCH CENTER DIRECTOR.

- 23 Of the funds appropriated to the Williston research center in subdivision 5 of section 1 of this
- 24 Act, \$210,000 from the general fund is contingent and subject to the provisions of this section. If
- 25 funding for fifty percent of the 2011-13 biennium costs relating to the director position at the
- 26 Williston research center is not provided by the Montana state university eastern agricultural
- 27 research center, the Williston research center may spend up to \$210,000 and hire one full-time
- equivalent director position for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
- 29 **SECTION 4. ADDITIONAL INCOME APPROPRIATION.** In addition to the amount
- included in the grand total special funds appropriation line item in section 1 of this Act, any other
- 31 income, including funds from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other

- 1 sources received by the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops
- 2 institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch
- 3 research centers, and agronomy seed farm, except as otherwise provided by law, is
- 4 appropriated for the purpose designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation, for the biennium
- 5 beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
- SECTION 5. TRANSFER AUTHORITY. Upon approval of the state board of agricultural research and education and appropriate branch research center directors, the director of the main research center may transfer appropriation authority within subdivisions 1, 2, 4, and 5 of
- 9 section 1 of this Act. Any amounts transferred must be reported to the director of the office of
- 10 management and budget.
- 11 SECTION 6. FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION ADJUSTMENTS. The board of higher
- 12 education may adjust or increase full-time equivalent positions as needed for the entities in
- 13 section 1 of this Act, subject to availability of funds. The board shall report any adjustments to
- the office of management and budget prior to the submission of the 2013-15 budget request.
- 15 **SECTION 7. UNEXPENDED GENERAL FUND EXCESS INCOME.** Any unexpended
- 16 general fund appropriation authority to and any excess income received by entities listed in
- 17 section 1 of this Act are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any
- 18 unexpended funds from these appropriations or revenues are available and may be expended
- by those entities, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.
- 20 SECTION 8. PERMANENT OIL TAX TRUST FUND DICKINSON RESEARCH CENTER -
- 21 **OPERATING POOL FUNDING.** The estimated income line item in subdivision 5 of section 1 of
- 22 this Act includes \$800,000 from the permanent oil tax trust fund. This funding is available only
- for defraying the costs of operations of the Dickinson research center, for the biennium
- 24 beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
- 25 **SECTION 9. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-14.2-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- amended and reenacted as follows:
- 27 4-14.2-02. Northern crops council Establishment Chairman Meetings -
- 28 Compensation.

- 1. The northern crops council is established. The council shall establish policies for the
- operation of the northern crops institute. The council consists of:

1 The president of North Dakota state university of agriculture and applied science a. 2 or the president's designee. 3 b. A representative selected by the North Dakota wheat commission. 4 A representative selected by the North Dakota oilseed council. C. 5 A representative selected by the North Dakota barley council. d. 6 A representative selected by the North Dakota soybean council. e. 7 f. The agriculture commissioner or the commissioner's designee. 8 Five to seven producers of northern crops selected by the members designated g. 9 in subdivisions a through f. 10 h. Up to four representatives of industries that process northern crops selected by 11 the members designated in subdivisions a through f. 12 2. The term of office for each member of the council, except the president of North <u>a.</u> 13 Dakota state university of agriculture and applied science and the agriculture 14 commissioner, is three years, and those members are limited to two 3-year 15 terms. Each term of office begins with the first reorganizational meeting after the 16 date of appointment. 17 <u>b.</u> Notwithstanding subdivision a, during the 2011-13 biennium, the council shall: 18 (1) Stagger by lot the terms of the producers of northern crops so that no more 19 than one of the producers' terms expires in June 2013; and 20 Stagger by lot the terms of the representatives of industries that process <u>(2)</u> 21 northern crops so that no more than one of the representatives' terms 22 expires in June 2013. 23 3. The chairman of the council must be a member of the council elected annually by a 24 majority vote of the council. Provided, the members designated in subdivisions a and f 25 of subsection 1 are not eligible to serve as chairman. 26 4. The council shall meet at least three times annually at such times and places as must 27 be determined by the council and may meet in special meeting upon such call and 28 notice as may be prescribed by rules adopted by the council. A council member unable 29 to attend a meeting of the council may be represented by a person who has a written 30 proxy from the member.

1 **SECTION 10. EXEMPTION.** The amounts appropriated for the research greenhouse 2 complex project, as contained in subdivision 4, section 3, of chapter 48 of the 2005 Session 3 Laws, and the branch center renovations and research greenhouse complex projects, as 4 contained in subdivision 4, section 1, of chapter 48 of the 2009 Session Laws, are not subject to 5 the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from these appropriations or 6 related revenues are available and may be expended during the biennium beginning July 1, 7 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. 8 **SECTION 11. EMERGENCY.** The appropriation for capital projects of \$6,991,650 from the 9 general fund and \$2,502,931 from special funds in subdivision 4 of section 1 of this Act is 10 declared to be an emergency measure.
