7	SECTIO	ON 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 21 of section 4-30-01 of the North Dakota Century
8	Code is ame	ended and reenacted as follows:
9	21. "Pa	asteurized Milk Ordinance" means the 20092011 revision of the Grade "A"
10	Pa	steurized Ordinance issued by the United States food and drug administration and
11	by	the United States department of agriculture's public health service.
12	SECTIO	N 2. A new subsection to section 4-30-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
13	created and	enacted as follows:
14	<u>"Sl</u>	hared animal ownership agreement" means any contractual arrangement under
15	<u>wh</u>	ich an individual:
16	<u>a.</u>	Acquires an ownership interest in a milk-producing animal;
17	<u>b.</u>	Agrees to pay another for, reimburse another for, or otherwise accept financial
18		responsibility for the care and boarding of the milk-producing animal at the dairy
19		farm; and
20	<u>C.</u>	Is entitled to receive a proportionate share of the animal's raw milk production as
21		a condition of the contractual arrangement.
22	SECTIO	N 3. AMENDMENT. Section 4-30-36.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is
23	amended ar	nd reenacted as follows:

A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 4-30-01 and two new sections

1	4-30-36.2. State milk sanitation rating and sampling surveillance officer - Duties -	
2	Guidelines.	
3	The state milk sanitation rating and sampling surveillance officer is responsible for the rating	
4	and certification of milk and dairy products. The rating and certification of milk and dairy	
5	products must be in accordance with the procedures outlined in the public health service/food	
6	and drug administration publication entitled "Methods of Making Sanitation Ratings of Milk	
7	Shippers - 20092011 Revision, Edition" and the sampling of milk and dairy products must be in	
8	accordance with the guidelines in the Standard Methods.	
9	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 4-30-36.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is	
10	amended and reenacted as follows:	
11	4-30-36.3. Milk laboratory evaluations officer - Duties - Guidelines.	
12	The milk laboratory evaluations officer is responsible for the certification and evaluation of	
13	milk and dairy products laboratories within the state. Evaluations and certification of milk	
14	laboratories must be made in accordance with the Standard Methods and the procedures	
15	outlined in the public health service/food and drug administration publication entitled "Evaluation	
16	of Milk Laboratories - 2009 2011 Edition".	
17	SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 4-30-36.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is	
18	amended and reenacted as follows:	
19	4-30-36.4. Grade A pasteurized milk ordinance.	
20	Dairy producers, processors, and manufacturers shall comply with the Pasteurized Milk	
21	Ordinance and follow the standards set by the "Procedures Governing the Cooperative	
22	State-Public Health Service Food and Drug Administration Program of the National Conference	
23	on Interstate Milk Shipments, 2009 2011 Revision".	
24	SECTION 6. A new section to chapter 4-30 of the North Dakota Century Code is created	
25	and enacted as follows:	
26	Shared animal ownership agreement - Raw milk.	
27	It is not a violation of this chapter to transfer or obtain raw milk under a shared animal	
28	ownership agreement. However, a person may not resell raw milk or raw milk products obtained	
29	under a shared animal ownership agreement.	
30	SECTION 7. A new section to chapter 4-30 of the North Dakota Century Code is created	
31	and enacted as follows:

1	Commissioner - Rulemaking authority - Limitation.
2	Notwithstanding chapter 28-32, the commissioner may not adopt any rule that restricts,
3	limits, or imposes additional requirements on any individual transferring or obtaining raw milk in
4	accordance with the terms of a shared animal ownership agreement.
5	SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - RAW MILK. During the 2013-14
6	interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the availability of raw or
7	unpasteurized milk, for human consumption, in this state. The study should examine the nature
8	and extent of governmental oversight with respect to the safety of the milk; the health of the
9	animals used to produce the milk; and the conditions under which the product is produced,
0	transferred, or obtained. The legislative management shall report its findings and
11	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
