3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$50,000, or so much of the
sum as may be necessary, to the department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of training
service dogs to assist North Dakota veterans having posttraumatic stress disorder, for the
biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

The legislative management shall 10 study statutory changes that would benefit North Dakota veterans and include therein possible 11 changes to state income taxes and property taxes, the provision of veteran-focused incentives, 12 assistance with obtaining and maintaining benefits, and assistance with obtaining and 13 maintaining various life-enhancing services. The legislative management shall study current 14 state and federal benefits available to North Dakota veterans. The legislative management shall 15 report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the 16 recommendations, to the sixty-fourth legislative assembly.
