- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the judicial branch;
- 2 and to amend and reenact sections 27-02-02 and 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to salaries of supreme and district court judges.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the judicial branch for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

27	otherwise appropriated, pursuant to federal acts and private gifts, grants, and donations for the			
28	purpose as designated in the federal acts or private gifts, grants, and donations for the			
29	biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

The 2013-15 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 2015-17 biennium. The supreme court shall report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-fourth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning

17 July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

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SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. The director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make such transfer of funds between line items of appropriation for the judicial branch of government as may be requested by the supreme court upon a finding by the court that the nature of the duties of the court and its staff requires the transfers to carry on properly the functions of the judicial branch of government.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 27-02-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

27-02-02. Salaries of justices of supreme court.

The annual salary of each justice of the supreme court is one hundred thirty-fourforty-five thousand one hundred thirty-fivesixty-seven dollars through June 30, 20122014, and one hundred thirty-eightfifty-two thousand onethree hundred fifty-ninetwenty dollars thereafter. The chief justice of the supreme court is entitled to receive an additional threefour thousand eightone hundred fifty-twosixty-six dollars per annum through June 30, 20122014, and threefour thousand ninethree hundred sixty-eightseventy-five dollars per annum thereafter.

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1 **SECTION 6. AMENDMENT.** Section 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 2 amended and reenacted as follows: 3 27-05-03. Salaries and expenses of district judges. 4 The annual salary of each district judge is one hundred twenty-twethirty-two thousand nine 5 hundred tentwenty-seven dollars through June 30, 2012 2014, and one hundred 6 twenty-sixthirty-nine thousand five hundred ninety-sevenseventy-three dollars thereafter. Each 7 district judge is entitled to travel expenses, including mileage and subsistence while engaged in 8 the discharge of official duties outside the city in which the judge's chambers are located. The 9 salary and expenses are payable monthly in the manner provided by law. A presiding judge of a 10 judicial district is entitled to receive an additional three thousand fiveeight hundred fiftyforty

dollars per annum through June 30, 20122014, and threefour thousand six hundred-
