1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the extension

2 service, northern crops institute, upper great plains transportation institute, main research

3 center, branch research centers, and agronomy seed farm; to provide for transfers; to provide

4 an exemption; to amend and reenact subsection 6 of section 4-05.1-19 of the North Dakota

5 <u>Century Code, relating to the duties of the state board of agricultural research and education;</u>

6 and to declare an emergency.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 9 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 10 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 11 other income, to the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops 12 institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch 13 research centers, and agronomy seed farm for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 14 North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops institute, the upper great 15 plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch research centers, and 16 agronomy seed farm, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as 17 follows: 18 Subdivision 1. 19 NORTH DAKOTA STATE UNIVERSITY EXTENSION SERVICE

29 The 2013-15 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the

30 2015-17 biennium. The main research center shall report to the appropriations committees of

- 1 the sixty-fourth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium
- 2 beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

3 SECTION 3. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION. In addition to the amount 4 included in the grand total special funds appropriation line item in section 1 of this Act, any other 5 income, including funds from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other 6 sources received by the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops 7 institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch 8 research centers, and agronomy seed farm, except as otherwise provided by law, is 9 appropriated for the purpose designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation, for the biennium 10 beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

11 SECTION 4. TRANSFER AUTHORITY. Upon approval of the state board of agricultural 12 research and education and appropriate branch research center directors, the director of the 13 main research center may transfer appropriation authority within subdivisions 1, 2, 4, and 5 of 14 section 1 of this Act. Any amounts transferred must be reported to the director of the office of 15 management and budget.

16 SECTION 5. FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION ADJUSTMENTS. The board of higher 17 education may adjust or increase full-time equivalent positions as needed for the entities in 18 section 1 of this Act, subject to availability of funds. The board shall report any adjustments to 19 the office of management and budget prior to the submission of the 2015-17 budget request. 20 SECTION 6. UNEXPENDED GENERAL FUND - EXCESS INCOME. Any unexpended 21 general fund appropriation authority to and any excess income received by entities listed in 22 section 1 of this Act are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any 23 unexpended funds from these appropriations or revenues are available and may be expended 24 by those entities, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 25 **SECTION 7. EXEMPTION.** The amounts appropriated for the research greenhouse 26 complex project, as contained in subdivision 4 of section 3 of chapter 48 of the 2005 Session

Laws and subdivision 4 of section 1 of chapter 19 of the 2011 Session laws, are not subject tothe provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from these appropriations or

related revenues are available and may be expended during the biennium beginning July 1.

30 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

SECTION 8. INTERNSHIP MATCHING FUNDS. The extension service line item in
subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act includes \$250,000 from the general fund for an extension
service internship program and agents-in-training program, for the biennium beginning July 1,
2013, and ending June 30, 2015. Internship program funds can be spent only to the extent that
matching funds have been secured from nonstate resources on a dollar-for-dollar cash basis.
SECTION 9. AMENDMENT. Subsection 6 of section 4-05.1-19 of the North Dakota Century
Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
6. Develop a biennial budget request based on its prioritized needs list and submit that
request to the president of North Dakota state university and the state board of higher
education, and forward its prioritized needs list and request without modification to the
office of management and budget and the appropriations committees of the legislative
assembly;
SECTION 10. EMERGENCY. The appropriation for capital projects of \$4,300,000 in
subdivision 4 of section 1 of this Act and \$1,900,000 in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act is
declared to be an emergency measure.
