## **SENATE BILL NO. 2052**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 26.1-36-09.15 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to individual and group health insurance coverage of telehealth services; and to amend
- 3 and reenact section 54-52.1-04.13 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to public
- 4 employees retirement system uniform group insurance coverage of telehealth services.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 SECTION 1. Section 26.1-36-09.15 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and 7 enacted as follows:
- 8 26.1-36-09.15. Coverage of telehealth services.
- 9 As used in this section:
- 10 "Distant site" means a site at which a health care provider or health care facility is a. 11 located while providing medical services by means of telehealth.
- 12 "Health care facility" means any office or institution at which health services are b. 13 provided. The term includes hospitals; clinics; ambulatory surgery centers; 14 outpatient care facilities; nursing homes; nursing, basic, long-term, or assisted 15

living facilities; laboratories; and offices of any health care provider.

- 16 "Health care provider" includes an individual licensed under chapter 43-05. <u>C.</u>
- 17 43-06, 43-12.1 as a registered nurse or as an advanced practice registered
- 18 nurse, 43-13, 43-15, 43-17, 43-26.1, 43-28, 43-32, 43-37, 43-40, 43-41, 43-42,
- 19 43-44, 43-45, 43-47, 43-58, or 43-60.
- 20 d. "Originating site" means a site at which a patient is located at the time health 21 services are provided to the patient by means of telehealth.
- 22 "Policy" means an accident and health insurance policy, contract, or evidence of <u>e.</u> 23 coverage on a group, individual, blanket, franchise, or association basis.

The term includes telehome 5 monitoring and interactive audio, video, and data communication. 6 "Telehealth": <del>g.</del> 7 Means the use of interactive audio, video, or other telecommunications <del>(1)</del> 8 technology that is used by a health care provider or health care facility at a 9 distant site to deliver health services at an originating site; and that is 10 delivered over a secure connection that complies with the requirements of 11 state and federal laws. 12 Includes the use of electronic media for consultation relating to the health-13 care diagnosis or treatment of a patient in real time or through the use of 14 store-and-forward technology. 15 Does not include the use of audio-only telephone, electronic mail, or 16 facsimile transmissions. 17 <del>2.</del> For all policies that become effective after June 30, 2015, and which do not extend-18 past June 30, 2017, the board shall provide health benefits coverage under a policy 19 that provides coverage for health services delivered by means of telehealth which is 20 the same as the coverage for health services delivered by in-person means. 21 <del>3.</del> Payment or reimbursement of expenses for covered health services delivered by 22 means of telehealth under this section may be established through negotiations 23 conducted by the board or the board's contractor with the health services providers in-24 the same manner as the board establishes payment or reimbursement of expenses for 25 covered health services that are delivered by in-person means. 26 Coverage under this section may be subject to deductible, coinsurance, and 27 copayment provisions. 28 <del>5.</del> This section does not require: 29 A policy to provide coverage for health services that are not medically necessary, 30 subject to the terms and conditions of the policy;
