- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 34-14-09.2 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to withholding of awarded paid time off; and to provide for application.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 34-14-09.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 6 34-14-09.2. Limitations on accrued paid time off - Investigation-

- If an employee separates from employment voluntarily, a private employer may
   withhold payment for accrued paid time off if:
- 9 a. At the time of hiring, the employer provided the employee written notice of the
  10 limitation on payment of accrued paid time off;
- b. The employee has been employed by the employer for less than one year; and
- 12 c. The employee gave the employer less than five days' written or verbal notice.
- 13 2. <u>If an employee separates from employment, a private employer may withhold payment</u>
   14 <u>for paid time off that has been</u>if:
- 15 a. The paid time off was awarded by the employer but not yet earned by the
   16 employee, if at the time of hiring; and
- b. Before awarding the paid time off, the employer provided the employee written
   notice of the limitation on payment of awarded paid time off.
- 193.As provided under section 34-14-05, an employee may report a violation under this20section. If a report of violation is made within thirty days of the alleged violation, the21labor commissioner shall investigate the merits of the claim. If a report is made more22than thirty days following the alleged violation, the commissioner may investigate the23merits of the claim.

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- 1 SECTION 2. APPLICATION. This Act applies to separations from employment which occur
- 2 on or after the effective date of this Act.
