1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to student identification cards issued by institutions of higher education  
3 under the supervision of the state board of higher education; and to amend and reenact  
4 subsection 1 of section 16.1-05-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to acceptable  
5 forms of identification to be eligible to vote.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

7 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created  
8 and enacted as follows:

9 **Student identification cards - Address required.**

10 A student photo identification card issued by an institution of higher education must include  
11 the date of birth and residential address of the student to whom the card is issued. When  
12 issuing identification cards to students, an institution of higher education shall provide each  
13 student with information regarding voter eligibility requirements.

14 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 16.1-05-07 of the North Dakota  
15 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 16 1. Before delivering a ballot to an individual according to section 16.1-13-22, the poll  
17 clerks shall require the individual to show identification, which includes the individual's  
18 residential address and date of birth. The identification may include:
- 19 a. A driver's license or nondriver identification card issued by the department of  
20 transportation or other official form of identification issued by the state;
  - 21 b. An official form of identification issued by a tribal government;
  - 22 c. A photo identification card issued by an institution of higher education under the  
23 supervision of the state board of higher education;

- 1           d. An alternative form of identification prescribed by the secretary of state, if the  
2           individual does not possess an official form of identification provided for under  
3           subdivision a, b, or c; or  
4           d.e. A combination of any of the forms of identification under subdivisions a through  
5           ed.
