- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for the display of Indian nation and service flags in public corridors

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 4 SECTION 1.
- 5 <u>Display of Indian nation flags State capitol.</u>
- The official flag of each Indian nation in this state must be displayed prominently in public
- 7 corridors of the state capitol, as determined by the capitol grounds planning commission.
- 8 **SECTION 2**.
- 9 <u>Display of service flags State capitol.</u>
- The official flags of the United States prisoners of war and missing in action, army, navy,
- 11 marine corps, air force, coast guard, and national guard must be displayed prominently in public
- 12 <u>corridors of the state capitol, as determined by the capitol grounds planning commission.</u>
