- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study election and lobbying
- 2 laws.

3 WHEREAS, in the two decades since the last comprehensive interim study of election laws,

4 there have been numerous United States Supreme Court decisions that have significantly

- 5 impacted the administration of elections and campaign finance law; and
- 6 WHEREAS, changes in election technology and voting methods have led to efficiencies in
- 7 election administration while also raising questions regarding ballot security and the potential for
- 8 manipulation of the election process; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the length and cost of election campaigns have increased greatly; and
- 10 **WHEREAS**, there has not been a comprehensive study of lobbying laws in this state;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

12 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 13 That the Legislative Management study election and lobbying laws; and
- 14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the study of election and lobbying laws include an
- 15 examination of election administration and voting methods, voter identification requirements,
- 16 residency requirements for voting and for candidates and elected officials, corrupt practices in
- 17 campaigns, campaign finance reporting requirements, and lobbyist registration and reporting;

- 19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
- 20 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 21 the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly.
