

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT  
with House Amendments  
ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2009**

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state fair  
2 association; to create and enact a new section to chapter 4-02.1 of the North Dakota Century  
3 Code, relating to facility operations or maintenance costs on the state fairgrounds; and to  
4 provide a statement of legislative intent.

**5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the state fair association for the purpose of defraying  
9 the expenses of the state fair association, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending  
10 June 30, 2019, as follows:

15 **SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding  
16 items approved by the sixty-fourth legislative assembly as adjusted for the 2015-17 biennium:

20 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - PREMIUMS.** It is the intent of the sixty-fifth  
21 legislative assembly that the state fair association use \$17,000 of its available operating funds  
22 to supplement funding for premiums appropriated in section 1 of this Act for the biennium  
23 beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

1       **SECTION 4.** A new section to chapter 4-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created  
2 and enacted as follows:

3       **Facility operations or maintenance costs.**

4       Except for costs resulting from a natural disaster, the state fair association may not pay for  
5 the cost of any of its facility operations or maintenance costs from the state general fund.
