- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the North Dakota
- 2 state university extension service, northern crops institute, upper great plains transportation
- 3 institute, main research center, branch research centers, and agronomy seed farm; to provide
- 4 for a legislative management study; to provide for a budget section report; and to provide an
- 5 exemption.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
other income, to the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops
institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch
research centers, and agronomy seed farm, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops institute, the upper great
plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch research centers, and
agronomy seed farm, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as
follows:

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SECTION 2. HEALTH INSURANCE INCREASE. The appropriation in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$2,141,727, of which \$1,268,815 is from the general fund, for increases in employee health insurance premiums from \$1,130 to \$1,241 per month.

SECTION 3. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO THE SIXTY-SIXTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding items approved by the sixty-fourth legislative assembly as adjusted for the 2015-17 biennium and the 2017-19 biennium one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

The 2017-19 biennium one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 2019-21 biennium. The upper great plains transportation institute, main and branch research centers, and North Dakota state university extension service shall report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-sixth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

SECTION 4. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION. In addition to the amount included in the grand total other funds appropriation line item in section 1 of this Act, any other income, including funds from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other sources received by the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops

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- 1 institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch 2 research centers, and agronomy seed farm, except as otherwise provided by law, is 3 appropriated for the purpose designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation, for the biennium 4 beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019. 5 SECTION 5. DICKINSON RESEARCH EXTENSION CENTER - MINERAL RIGHTS 6 **INCOME.** The Dickinson research extension center may spend up to \$755,000 of revenues 7 received during the 2017-19 biennium from mineral royalties, leases, or easements for ongoing 8 operational expenses. Any revenues received in excess of \$755,000 may be spent only for 9 one-time expenditures for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019. 10 SECTION 6. WILLISTON RESEARCH EXTENSION CENTER - MINERAL RIGHTS 11 **INCOME - REPORT.** The Williston research extension center shall report to the appropriations 12 committees of the sixty-sixth legislative assembly on amounts received and spent from mineral 13 royalties, leases, or easements in the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 14 2017, and the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019. 15 SECTION 7. TRANSFER AUTHORITY. Upon approval of the state board of agricultural 16 research and education and appropriate branch research center directors, the director of the 17 main research center may transfer appropriation authority within subdivisions 1, 2, 4, and 5 of 18 section 1 of this Act. Any amounts transferred must be reported to the director of the office of 19 management and budget. 20 SECTION 8. FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION ADJUSTMENTS. The state board of 21 higher education may adjust or increase full-time equivalent positions as needed for the entities 22 in section 1 of this Act, subject to availability of funds. All full-time or part-time positions must be 23 separate from North Dakota state university. Annually, the board shall report to the office of 24 management and budget and to the budget section any adjustments made pursuant to this 25 section. 26 SECTION 9. UNEXPENDED GENERAL FUND - EXCESS INCOME. Any unexpended
 - general fund appropriation authority to and any excess income received by entities listed in section 1 of this Act are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from these appropriations or revenues are available and may be expended by those entities, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.

1 **SECTION 10. EXEMPTION.** The amounts appropriated for the veterinary diagnostic 2 laboratory and the seed cleaning plants contained in subdivision 4 of section 1 of chapter 20 of 3 the 2015 Session Laws, are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any 4 unexpended funds from these appropriations or related revenues are available and may be 5 expended during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019. 6 SECTION 11. UPPER GREAT PLAINS TRANSPORTATION INSTITUTE - ROAD AND 7 BRIDGE ASSET MANAGEMENT SYSTEM MATCHING FUNDS. Subdivision 3 of section 1 of 8 this Act includes \$100,000 from the general fund for a road and bridge asset management 9 system which may be spent only to the extent the upper great plains transportation institute 10 provides two dollars of matching funds from nonstate sources for each one dollar provided from 11 the general fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019. 12 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - STATE SOIL CONSERVATION 13 **COMMITTEE.** During the 2017-18 interim, the legislative management shall study the state soil 14 conservation committee. The study must include a review of the duties, responsibilities, and 15 related costs and efficiencies of the committee and related North Dakota state university 16 extension service staff, the needs of the soil conservation districts, and the necessity to 17 continue the state soil conservation committee. The legislative management shall report its 18 findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the 19 recommendations, to the sixty-sixth legislative assembly. 20 SECTION 13. STATE BOARD OF AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH AND EDUCATION -21 NORTH DAKOTA STATE UNIVERSITY EXTENSION SERVICE STUDY - BUDGET SECTION 22 **REPORT.** During the 2017-18 interim, the state board of agricultural research and education, in 23 consultation with the office of the governor, shall study the duties and responsibilities of the 24 North Dakota state university extension service. The study must include a review of the mission, 25 existing programs, the efficiency and effectiveness of the delivery methods for existing 26 programs, and potential program changes. The state board of agricultural research and 27 education shall report its findings and recommendations to increase the efficiency and 28 effectiveness of the North Dakota state university extension service to the budget section of the 29 legislative management by March 31, 2018.
