- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 39-05-17.2 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to motor vehicle body damage disclosure.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 39-05-17.2 of the North Dakota

- 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- As used in this section, "motor vehicle body damage" means a change in the body or
 structure of a motor vehicle, generally resulting from a vehicular crash or accident,
- 8 including loss by fire, vandalism, weather, or submersion in water, resulting in damage
- 9 to the motor vehicle which equals or exceeds the greater of eighten thousand dollars
- 10 or fortytwenty-five percent of the predamage retail value of the motor vehicle as
- 11 determined by the national automobile dealers association official used car guide. The
- 12 term does not include body or structural modifications, normal wear and tear, glass
- 13 damage, hail damage, or items of normal maintenance and repair.
