- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 4 SECTION 1.
- 5 <u>Display of prisoner of war and missing in action flag State capitol.</u>
- The prisoner of war and missing in action flag must be flown daily on all outdoor,
- 7 permanent, flagpole locations on the state capitol grounds on the middle flagpole on the east
- 8 side of the heritage center and on a flagpole in front of the all veterans memorial. The prisoner
- 9 of war and missing in action flag may be displayed on its own flagpole or under the flag of the
- 10 United States.
