- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-66 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to written advisory opinions regarding ethics.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-66 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

## 6 Advisory opinions - Authority - Effect.

- 7 <u>1.</u> In response to a request from a public official, candidate for elected office, or lobbyist,
- 8 the ethics commission may provide a written advisory opinion regarding the
- 9 application of the following to a specified set of hypothetical or actual facts:
- 10 <u>a.</u> <u>Article XIV of the Constitution of North Dakota; or</u>
- 11b.State statutes and ethics commission rules related to transparency, corruption,12elections, and lobbying.
- <u>Within fourteen days after receiving a request for a written advisory opinion, the ethics</u>
  commission shall notify the requester whether an opinion will be provided.
- <u>3.</u> Within ninety days after notifying a requester that a written advisory opinion will be
  issued, the ethics commission shall issue the opinion.
- 17 <u>4.</u> <u>Criminal and civil penalties may not be imposed upon an individual for an action taken</u>
  18 <u>in accordance with an opinion issued under this section if:</u>
- 19 <u>a.</u> <u>The individual acts in good faith; and</u>
- 20b.The material facts surrounding the action taken are the same as the facts21presented in the opinion.
- <u>5.</u> Opinions and requests for opinions under this section are open records, except names
  of persons in the opinions and requests are exempt records.

- 2 <u>section on a website or in another medium readily available to the public.</u>
