3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-66 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 Advisory opinions - Authority - Effect. 7 In response to a request from a public official, candidate for elected office, or lobbyist, 1. 8 the ethics commission may provide a written advisory opinion regarding the 9 application of the following to a specified set of hypothetical facts or actual 10 facts prospective conduct: 11 Article XIV of the Constitution of North Dakota; or a. 12 State statutes and ethics commission rules related to transparency, corruption, b. 13 elections, and lobbying. 14 2. Within fourteen days after receiving a request for a written advisory opinion, the ethics 15 commission shall notify the requester whether an opinion will be provided. 16 Within ninety days after notifying a requester that a written advisory opinion will be 3. 17 issued, the ethics commission shall issue the opinion. 18 <u>4.</u> Criminal and civil penalties may not be imposed upon an individual for an action taken 19 in accordance with an opinion issued under this section if: 20 a. The individual acts in good faith; and 21 The material facts surrounding the action taken are substantially the same as the b. 22 facts conduct presented in the opinion. 23 Opinions and requests for opinions under this section are open records, except names 5. 24 of persons in the opinions and requests are exempt records.
