- 7 <u>1. A board-approved salon may have an apprentice program. To qualify for board</u>
 8 approval:
 - a. A salon must have at least one board-approved cosmetologist and must comply with rules adopted by the board.
 - <u>A cosmetologist must have been licensed as a cosmetologist for at least eight</u>
 <u>years, must be an instructor, and must be working as a cosmetologist for a</u>
 <u>minimum of twenty-five hours per week.</u>
 - 2. A student may qualify to be an apprentice if the student has completed at least six hundred hours of cosmetology education and completed the standards of the school of cosmetology. An apprentice may assist in any of the practices of cosmetology under the immediate direction and supervision of a board-approved cosmetologist. An apprentice may obtain no more than three hundred hours of apprenticeship experience in the practice of cosmetology.
