- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-10-18.3 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to free tuition for dependents of disabled veterans or veterans killed in action.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15-10-18.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15-10-18.3. Free tuition in North Dakota institutions of higher education.
- AnyA dependent, as defined in section 15-10-18.2, upon being duly accepted for enrollment
- 8 into anyan undergraduate degree or certificate program of a North Dakota state institution of
- 9 higher education, must be allowed to obtain a bachelor's degree or certificate of completion, for
- 10 so long as the dependent is eligible, free of any tuition and fee charges if the bachelor's degree-
- 11 or certificate of completion is earned within a forty-five-month or ten-semester period or its
- 12 equivalent and if tuition and fee charges do not include costs for aviation flight charges or
- expenses. Once an individual qualifies as a dependent under sections 15-10-18.2 and
- 14 15-10-18.3 this section, the dependent may not be disqualified from the benefits of this section:
- 15 1. Due to the return of the prisoner of war;
- 16 2. Due to the return of the individual missing in action; or
- Because the veteran through whom the benefit was obtained had a one hundred
 percent service-connected disability at the time of death.
