- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-01-04.1 and subsection 2 of section
- 2 <u>16.1-15-08</u> of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to proof of citizenship.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-01-04.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 16.1-01-04.1. Identification verifying eligibility as an elector. 7 1. A qualified elector shall provide a valid form of identification to the proper election 8 official before receiving a ballot for voting. 9 2. The identification must provide the following information regarding the elector: 10 Legal name; a. 11 Current residential street address in North Dakota; and b. 12 c. Date of birth. 13 3. a. A valid form of identification is: 14 (1) A driver's license or nondriver's identification card issued by the North 15 Dakota department of transportation; or 16 An official form of identification issued by a tribal government to a tribal (2) 17 member residing in this state. 18 If an individual's valid form of identification does not include all the information b. 19 required under subsection 2 or the information on the identification is not current, 20 the identification must be supplemented by presenting any of the following issued 21 to the individual which provides the missing or outdated information: 22 (1) A current utility bill;
- 23 (2) A current bank statement;

1		(3)	A check issued by a federal, state, or local government;
2		(4)	A paycheck;
3		(5)	A document issued by a federal, state, or local government; or
4		(6)	A printed document containing all of the information required by
5			subsection 2 issued by an institution of higher education for an enrolled
6			student residing in the state and containing the institution's letterhead or
7			seal, along with a student photo identification card issued by the institution
8			and containing the student's photograph and legal name.
9	4.	The follo	owing forms of identification are valid for the specified individuals living under
10		special	circumstances who do not possess a valid form of identification under
11		subsect	ion 3.
12		a. Fo	r an individual living in a long-term care facility, a long-term care certificate
13		pre	escribed by the secretary of state and issued by a long-term care facility in this
14		sta	ite;
15		b. Fo	r a uniformed service member or immediate family member temporarily
16		sta	ationed away from the individual's residence in this state, or a resident of the
17		sta	te temporarily living outside the country, a current military identification card or
18		pa	ssport; and
19		c. Fo	r an individual living with a disability that prevents the individual from traveling
20		aw	ay from the individual's home, the signature on an absentee or mail ballot
21		ар	plication from another qualified elector who, by signing, certifies the applicant
22		is a	a qualified elector.
23	5.	If an ind	lividual is not able to show a valid form of identification but asserts
24		qualifica	ations as an elector in the precinct in which the individual desires to vote, the
25		individu	al may mark a ballot that must be securely set aside <u>securely</u> in a sealed
26	I	envelop	e designed by the secretary of state. After the ballot is set aside, the individual
27		may sho	ow a valid form of identification to either a polling place election board member
28		if the inc	dividual returns to the polling place before the polls close, or to an employee of
29		the offic	e of the election official responsible for the administration of the election via
30		print or	electronic means before the meeting of the canvassing board occurring on the
31		thirteen	th day after the election. Each ballot set aside under this subsection must be

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1	presented to the members of the canvassing board for proper inclusion or exclusion
2	from the tally.

19		of citizenship under this subsection may be presented via paper or electronic		
20		means This section does not effect any associated consent decree or administrative		
21		rules adopted related to a consent decree consented to or enacted before August 1,		
22		<u>2023.</u>		
23	<u>7.</u>	The secretary of state shall develop uniform procedures for the requirements of		
24		subsection<u>subsections</u> 5 <u>and 6</u> which must be followed by the election official		
25		responsible for the administration of the election.		
26	SEG	CTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 16.1-15-08 of the North Dakota		
27	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:			
28	2.	Each ballot within a sealed envelope set aside for an individual who was unable to		
29		provide a valid form of identification when appearing to vote in the electionas outlined		
30		in subsections 5 and 6 of section 16.1-01-04.1 must be delivered to the election official		
31		responsible for the administration of the election so the envelope containing the ballot		

1	is available if the individual for whom the ballot was set aside appears in the official's
2	office to verify the individual's eligibility as an elector. The verified and unverified
3	ballots set aside must be delivered to the members of the canvassing board for proper
4	inclusion in or exclusion from the canvass of votes.
