- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 11-11 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 40-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the power of counties and
- 3 municipalities to prohibit local development by a foreign adversary; to amend and reenact

4 section 47-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the prohibition on ownership of

5 real property by a foreign adversary; and to declare an emergency.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 11-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
8 and enacted as follows:

9 **Development by a foreign adversary - Prohibition.**

10 <u>1.</u> <u>A board of county commissioners, including a board in a home rule county, may not</u>

11 procure, authorize, or approve a development agreement, building plan, or proposal

- relating to county development with an individual or government identified as a foreign
 adversary under 15 CFR 7.4(a).
- 14 <u>2.</u> <u>This section does not apply to a foreign adversary defined under subsection 1</u>
- 15 possessing an interest in real property if the foreign adversary:
- 16a.Is a duly registered business and has maintained a status of good standing with17the secretary of state for seven years or longer before the effective date of this18Act;
- 19b.Has been approved by the committee for foreign direct investment in the United20States; and
- 21 <u>c.</u> <u>Maintains an active national security agreement with the federal government.</u>

11	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
