Sixty-eighth Legislative Assembly

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Bismarck, January 24, 2023

The Senate convened at 1:00 p.m., with President Miller presiding.

The prayer was offered by Reverend Gretchen Deeg, United Church of Christ, Bismarck.

The roll was called and all members were present except Senator Erbele.

A quorum was declared by the President.

MOTION

SEN. KLEIN MOVED that the Senate reconsider its action whereby SB 2118 passed, which motion prevailed on a verification vote.
