HOLIDAYS FOLLOWING SUNDAY

AN ACT

To amend and reenact section 1-0302 of the North Dakota Revised Code of 1943, relating to holidays which fall upon a Sunday.

Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. Amendment.) Section 1-0302 of the North Dakota Revised Code of 1943 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

1-0302. When Day Following Holiday Shall Be A Holiday.) If the first day of January, the twelfth day of February, the twenty-second day of February, the fourth day of July, the thirtieth day of May, the eleventh day of November, or the twenty-fifth day of December falls upon a Sunday, the Monday following shall be the holiday.

VALIDATION OF INSTRUMENTS AFFECTING TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

AN ACT

- To amend and reenact section 1-0401 of the North Dakota Revised Code of 1943, relating to validation of instruments affecting title to real estate.
- Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. Amendment.) Section 1-0401 of the North Dakota Revised Code of 1943 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

1-0401. Execution, Acknowledgment, Filing, And Recording Legalized.) The execution, acknowledgment, filing, and recording of all deeds, leases, mortgages, assignments, satisfactions, and other instruments in writing affecting the title to real property in this state, in good faith made, taken, or certified prior to January 1, 1953, and which have been filed or recorded in the proper counties of this state, hereby are declared to be legal and valid for all purposes, anything in the laws of the state of North Dakota, or of any other state, territory, or country at the time of such execution, acknowledgment, filing, or recording to the contrary notwithstanding.
