
Dear Ms. Fordahl:

NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND
ADMINISTRATIVE RULES RELATING TO
N.D. ADMIN. CODE CHAPTER 75-02-02
MEDICAL SERVICES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Health and Human Services will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code chapter 75-02-02 at 11:30 a.m. on Monday, September 18, 2023, in Bismarck, N.D. in Room 210, located on the second floor of the Judicial Wing of the State Capitol.

The proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code chapter 75-02-02, Medical Services, are necessary, in part, to comply with 2023 House Bill No. 1044 and 2023 Senate Bill No. 2156.

The proposed changes are as follows:

Section 75-02-02-03 is amended to refer to the “department of health and human services”.

Section 75-02-02-03.2 is amended to update the correct titles of entities, to remove a defined term that is no longer used, and to update language used.

Subsections 1 and 2 of section 75-02-02-08 are amended to incorporate person centered language, to update language for clarification purposes, and to update the definition of “preventive services”.

Subsections 1 and 6 of section 75-02-02-09 are amended to update the correct title of the Department.

Section 75-02-02-09.5 is amended to replace “person” with “individual” and “client” with “recipient”.

Subsection 1 of section 75-02-02-11 is amended to update the correct title for “Indian health service”.

Section 75-02-02-12 is amended to replace “primary care provider” with “enrolled in-state provider”.

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Section 75-02-02-13 is amended to remove references to the primary care case management program, which was repealed by 2023 House Bill No. 1044, to create a definition of “enrolled in-state provider”, and to replace “primary care provider” with “enrolled in-state provider”.

Section 75-02-02-13.1 is amended to allow family members to enroll as transportation service providers and update the criteria for transportation services, to clarify the Department’s role, to update language, and to replace “person” with “individual”.

Section 75-02-02-13.2 is amended to incorporate person centered language.

Section 75-02-02-27 is amended to reflected changes made to medical assistance prior authorization in 2023 Senate Bill No. 2156 and to update language.

Section 75-02-02-29 is repealed pursuant to the repeal of the primary care case management program by 2023 House Bill No. 1044.

The proposed amendments are not anticipated to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. No taking of real property is involved in this rulemaking action.
