## NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES RELATING TO N.D. ADMIN. CODE CHAPTER 33-04-12 CORRECTION AND AMENDMENT OF VITAL RECORDS

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Health and Human Services will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code chapter 33-04-12 at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, September 18, 2023, in Bismarck, N.D. in Room 210, located on the second floor of the Judicial Wing of the State Capitol.

The proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code chapter 33-04-12, Correction and Amendment of Vital Records, are being proposed to comply with 2023 House Bill No. 1297.

The proposed changes are as follows:

**Section 33-04-12-01** is amended to replace "person" with "individual".

Section 33-04-12-02 is amended to replace "person" with "individual". The section is amended to update the process to amend the birth record of an individual who has undergone an acceptable sex reassignment surgery. The section is also amended to provide that the vital records office shall maintain a list of acceptable sex reassignment surgeries that must be routinely reviewed, and to require that the acceptable sex reassignment surgeries must change an individual's sex with the correct genitalia of the new identified sex and remove the sexual function of the previous sex.

Section 33-04-12-04 is amended to replace "person" with "an individual".

Section 33-04-12-07 is amended to replace "persons" "individuals".

The proposed amendments are not anticipated to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. No taking of real property is involved in this rulemaking action.
