## FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT, AMEND, ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Board of Psychologist Examiners will hold a public hearing to address proposed **amendments to and enact**, N.D. Admin. Code **Psychologist Licensure, 66-02-01-03, section 2, line D and enact 66-04** at 3:00 p.m. on Friday, February 9, 2024, at the Badlands Human Service Center, 1463 I-94 Business Loop E, Dickinson, ND 58601. The purpose of the proposed **rule and amendment** is to **implement statutes, and a new predoctoral psychology internship program**. The proposed **rule and amendment**, address(es) protocol for NDSBPE when a licensee practices in North Dakota without a license and outlines the predoctoral psychology internship program.

The proposed **rule and amendment is not** expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

**The proposed rulemaking implements bill number SB 2205, enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning the Board being able to adopt rules and standards to establish a predoctoral supervised psychological internship program.**
