Senate Bill No. 2308 - DHS - Program and Policy - Senate Action

This bill provides funding for compulsive gambling prevention, awareness, rehabilitation, and treatment services. Of the \$89,000 general fund appropriation, \$39,000 is for the development of gambling counselor certification standards.

Senate Bill No. 2308 - DHS - Program and Policy - House Action

The House did not change the level of funding, but did remove the provision requiring \$39,000 of this funding to be used for the development of gambling counselor certification standards.

Senate Bill No. 2308 - DHS - Program and Policy - Conference Committee Action

The Senate acceded to the House amendments and further amended to provide that \$1,000 of the \$89,000 appropriation may be designated for per diem and travel expenses of in-state professional boards to gather information.
