


Other Sections in Bill

Transfers - Section 4 allows transfers of funds between line items of appropriations for the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council as requested by the Chairman of the Legislative Management.

Continuation of appropriation authority - Section 5 provides that the unspent funds appropriated for the Legislative Assembly and the Legislative Council for the 2011-13 biennium be continued and that unexpended appropriations enacted prior to the 2011-13 biennium may be cancelled as directed by the Chairman of the Legislative Management.

Compensation - Sections 6 and 7 increase legislators' daily pay during legislative sessions, monthly compensation, and additional monthly compensation by 3 percent for each year of the 2013-15 biennium. Sections 8 and 9 of the bill increase interim meeting pay by 3 percent for each year of the 2013-15 biennium.

Legislative services fund - North Dakota Century Code Section 54-35-19 - This fund is used for depositing and spending funds relating to legislative information.

Senate Bill No. 2223 - Appropriates \$100,000 from the general fund to the Legislative Management for a study of the feasibility and desirability of constructing a facility to house economic development functions of state government on Bank of North Dakota land
